
Westchester Riverwalk Connection: Recent Progress






Option B: Van Wart Trail Connection

- 2,900'-longwaterfrontesplanade alongriver
- Two Metro-North
 Railroad crossings
 at former signal
 bridge and Van
 Wart Node
- Path connects to the Van Wart neighborhood and Lyndhurst
- Path access to waterfront peninsula with overlooks
- Potential waterfront overlooks/fishing piers
